### **Reconstruction of Intersection - Rodeo Road at Richards Avenue beginning Monday, March 26, 2007**

The City of Santa Fe and its contractor, A.S. Horner, Inc. of Albuquerque will commence reconstruction of the intersection of Rodeo Road at Richards Avenue on Monday, March 26, 2007. The project is expected to take approximately six months, weather permitting.

The project scope includes widening of the intersection to provide:

- Dual left-turns from Rodeo Road, southbound onto Richards Avenue and;
- Dual left-turns from Richards Avenue, westbound onto Rodeo Road
- Updated traffic signal equipment
- Improved access for pedestrians and bicyclists
- Intersection capacity

The contractor will begin work with the reconstruction of the walls on the north side of Rodeo Road to secure residential privacy for the duration of the project.
